Look for something different. The idea of a timepiece that has to be wound by hand should be considered if a person plans to keep the timepiece for many years and wants it to work well and gain value as the years go by. For the highest quality, a person often turns to the old style of watches. Be aware of the quality of any watch you purchase to make sure that it will last and be less susceptible to damage in the future. Inexpensive watches are made with glass or plastic, which scratch far more easily.

Don't be fooled by fake timepieces. It is worth paying a little extra to a professional dealer to ensure that you are getting what you think you are buying. There's a lot of counterfeiting in the watch business, so eBay and estate sales are very risky.

Keep the watch maintained. Just like a person does with their car, a good timepiece needs periodic work done on to keep it running at its best, but make sure to take it to a professional. If you do not use a person who is trained in watch repair, you could do more damage than good. Caring for a quartz-movement watch is really just a matter of changing the battery. Most of the batteries are lithium and last about five to six years.

Picking a watch as a gift is just a matter of remembering just a couple of things. Get out shopping ahead of time. Not only will a person get to enjoy a classic timepiece for years, but they will get something to show off too.
