For the serious multi-media user, the [Samsung Wave 2](#) comes equipped with a microSD slot for up to 16GB of expandable memory - an option to take advantage of if the user wants to play back MP3s or use the 3 megapixel camera to shoot still images or SD video. It even comes with image editing software to touch up your images on the go, along with MP4 video viewing capabilities. The expansion slot provides another handy feature - the user can use separate cards for various media and interchange cards as desired.
